**Colorado Springs, CO** – The American Red Cross Pikes Peak Chapter will be closing the shelter at the Springs of Life Church at 3704 E. Uintah at 3:00 P.M. today, Thursday, January 18 and relocating to the **First Presbyterian Church, Youth Ministries Building at 219 E. Bijou in Colorado Springs. This Red Cross Service Center will open on, Friday, January 19 at 9:00 A.M.** to assist those affected by the Castle West Apartment Fire. Red Cross volunteer caseworkers will be on hand to provide emergency relief to the victims including counseling services. If clients need assistance between Thursday, January 18 3:00 P.M. and Friday, January 19 9:00 A.M., please call the Red Cross at (719) 632-3563.

The Red Cross is still receiving phone calls from family members of those that lived at the Castle West Apartment Fire, looking for information on the safety of their relatives. If you were a resident of the Castle West Apartments and have not yet information the Red Cross of your safety, please do so by calling (719) 632-3563. Concerned family members may also call (719) 632-3563 to check on the safety of their loved ones.
