Become an Authorized Provider

What is an Authorized Provider?

An individual or organization who is certified to offer Red Cross programs at your facility, with your own Red Cross trained instructors. Teach courses to employees of your business or members of your organization – whenever and wherever you want. Teaching life saving courses provides an excellent benefit to your employees and ensures you have trained people on hand to respond to unexpected emergencies. By sending one of your employees to our New Instructor Training class, you can teach the American Red Cross courses in-house as often as you'd like. Training to become an American Red Cross instructor involves two days of training and a commitment to teach at least one class every two years to maintain certification. Materials and equipment for the classes you teach can be purchased from us and you may choose to rent the training manikins, AED trainers and training DVDs.

How Do I Become an Authorized Provider?

- Step 1— Register for the New Instructor Training class at \$180 per person. View the schedule for this course and register on our website at www.pparc.org
- Step 2— Complete and submit the Authorized Provider Application which will provided by you at the time of the New Instructor Training or can be obtained by contacting Matt Reeves at (719) 785-2713 or mreeves@pparc.org in Colorado Springs or Christina Collins at (719) 561-2614 or ccollins@sepparc.org in Pueblo
- Step 3— We will draft your Authorized Provider Agreement and present to you for review and signature. You will then receive a Welcome Kit with all of the necessary instructions, forms, etc.
- Step 4— Purchase and/or rent the materials and equipment that you need and begin teaching whenever you'd like! Turn in your Course Records to us after you teach a class and we'll process the certification cards for you.

How Much Does It Cost to Teach a Class?

The cost of teaching a class depends on the class you're teaching and how many students you teach. If you're teaching a Lay Responder First Aid and Infant, Child and Adult CPR/AED course, these are the costs associated with that course:

Manikin Rental	\$12 each	(1 per 2 students)
AED Trainer Rental	\$12 each	(1 per 2 students)
DVD Rental	\$10	(1 per course)
Manikin Faceshields	\$10 for roll of 36	(1 shield per student)
First Aid Training Pack	\$2 each	(1 per student)
Adult FA/CPRAED		
Ready Reference	\$3.00 each (or free online)	(1 per student – optional)
Pediatric FA/CPR/AED		
Ready Reference	\$3.00 each (or free online)	(1 per student – optional)
Participant Workbook	\$8.50 each (or free online)	(1 per student)
Administrative Fee	\$10 each	(assessed per student, per class)
