

Becoming an Instructor

CPR for the Professional Rescuer

1 Register for the New Instructor Training class for \$200. This is a 20-hour course held on a Friday evening and then two Saturdays. The first 4 hours on Friday are spent taking the adult, infant & child CPR/AED and first aid skills and written test so it is recommended that you've had these basic courses prior to the Instructor course or come in prior to the first night to pick up the course materials to study. The first Saturday will cover the Fundamentals of Instructor Training component. The second Saturday is spent on teach-backs and evaluations.

2 If you complete and pass the course, you will receive your Lay Responder First Aid/Adult, Infant & Child CPR/AED instructor authorization.

3 Follow steps 1-3 that are outlined below.

1 Order the self-study instructor materials for CPR PR:

2 At your own pace, orient yourself to the material by reading the Instructor Manual and Participant Book and watching the DVD.

3 Call Larry Decker at (719) 785-2713 to schedule an appointment at which time you will take the student-level written test and practice the skills on a manikin. If you pass this student Challenge course, you will then take the written instructor test and complete the Self Study Verification form; ask any questions you might have about the material and receive your instructor authorization certification.
