

Becoming an Instructor

Wilderness and Remote First Aid

1 Register for the New Instructor Training class for \$175. This is a 16-hour course held over two days from 8am – 4pm. The first morning is spent taking the adult, infant & child CPR/AED and first aid skills and written test so it is recommended that you've had these basic courses prior to the Instructor course or come in prior to the first night to pick up the course materials to study. The rest of the first day will cover the Fundamentals of Instructor Training component. The second day is spent on teach-backs and evaluations.

2 If you complete and pass the course, you will receive your Lay Responder First Aid/ Adult, Infant & Child CPR/AED instructor authorization.

3 Purchase the self-study instructor materials for WFA:
