A challenge class may be taken only once and the skills test must be passed before the written test is given. If failed, a full course must be taken to obtain certification. All responsibility for preparing for the challenge course rests solely with the participant. Please note: Component books and skills cards are included in the price of this class. If you would like to have those materials to study prior to the date of the class, you may come in to our office to pick those up.

Babysitter's Training — \$75

Available for youth ages 11-15. Modules include responsibilities of babysitters, job interviews, child development, infant care, accident prevention, first aid, rescue breathing, choking victims, handling strangers at the door and on the phone, changing diapers and checking a conscious/unconscious child/infant. This course does include CPR child & Infant and First Aid. Students will receive a Babysitting Portfolio and a Babysitter's Handbook (this full-color handbook is filled with great information and resources to use in class and on the job), Babysitter's training Emergency Reference Guide (be prepared with this compact booklet that provides step-by-step instructions to handle common emergencies such as asthma attacks, burns and cuts), Babysitter's Training CD-ROM (this CD-ROM provides the tools you need to run your babysitting business, including a babysitter's organizer; a printable activity booklet with games, crafts, song an recipes; a resume template; interactive exercises to help you practice skills and more).
